To Whom It May Concern:

Thank you for reaching out to Wilbur Charter for Enriched Academics in regards to applying for the Neighborhood Purposes Grant (NPG). I would like to begin introducing you to the Wilbur Charter Family.

Wilbur Charter for Enriched Academics serves a heterogeneous mix of ethnicities, religions, economic backgrounds and ability levels. As part of the larger Los Angeles Unified School District, we educate transitional kindergarten through 5th grade students, with our enrollment averaging about 640 students over the past five years. Additionally, we have a special education Pre-School program for 3-5 year olds with special needs. The racial and ethnic makeup of Wilbur has historically remained the same. Approximately 76% of our students are White, including Russian, Israeli, Iranian, and Armenian. The next highest ethnicity is Hispanic, with about 13% of our students falling into that ethnicity. The number of African-American and Asian students has stayed about the same over the same period, with an average of 4% for each. There are several languages spoken at Wilbur CEA, contributing to a rise in the number of English Learners over this same time period. The amount of Spanish speakers has stayed relatively the same, while there has been an increase in Hebrew, Russian, Farsi and Armenian speaking students.

If our school receives the Neighborhood Purposes Grant, we would like to use the money from this grant to improve the Wilbur Charter community by displaying murals throughout our school. Wilbur Charter for Enriched Academics's focus of the murals would be to celebrate the diversity on our school campus as well as the natural beauty of the City of Tarzana. Creating these murals on our school campus will provide a way for our diverse community to communicate values, appreciates, and/or wants to see for our future. Murals would provide a sense of beauty and would also give a sense of ownership back to the students, our stakeholders, and community. Thank you in advance.
