JOINT TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE and BOARD MEETING

May 22, 2019

1. The meeting was called to order at 6:33 PM.
2. Approval of minutes of April 15, 2019 meeting. Motion by Bob, seconded by Harvey. Unanimously approved
3. Public comments. None.
4. Unlawful truck and RV parking on various streets in Tarzana: No real progress has been made. Max will follow up with appropriate City agency responsible for supervising enforcement. At the request of a stakeholder, who says he represents other stakeholders, to place parking meters on Philipprimm and Wilbur, Max asked Councilman Blumenfield’s office for the Councilman’s position on installing those meters. The Council office replied that, unless there is strong support from the community, the Councilman would not support placing the meters.
5. Request to Caltrans to place notice of exit closures a reasonable distance prior to the last open offramp (i.e., “second exit ahead closed”): Max has not received any response to his initial correspondence. He has sent follow-ups.
6. Request to City agencies to require input from involved areas before implementing “road diets” and “traffic calming” measures: Council Office has promised to let us know of any proposed “road diets” and “traffic calming” measures affecting us and will accept our Community Impact Statements
7. Condition of roadway on Avenida Hacienda, north and south of Linnet St.: Some repairs have been made.
8. Request to paint mid-line stripe on Greenbriar, from Vanalden to Ellenita: Work has been completed.

10. Future agenda items and other calendar events. Date of next meeting Wednesday, June 19th.
