Request to LADOT for passenger loading zone at Whole Foods. Per the Chief Engineer for the West Valley this can’t be accomplished since there is not sufficient room to meet ADA requirements for a passenger loading/drop-off zone.

“Photo-enforced” stop sign at Vanalden/Santa Rita. According to LAPD this is not a LA City installed camera. It must have been installed or simulated by a resident in the area.
