If multiple speaker cards are submitted on one agenda item, preference will be granted to members of the public who have not spoken previously during the meeting, either during public comment or on another agenda item. Public comment will be limited to 2 minutes unless adjusted by the presiding officer

Please note that under the Brown Act, the Board is prevented from acting on a matter that you bring to its attention during the General Public Comment period; however, the issue raised by a member of the public may become the subject of a future Board meeting. Whereas during this entire time the Tarzana community has been divided between the Encino/Tarzana and the Reseda/West Van Nuys Community Plans, and

Whereas, in its March 2019 report the City Planning Department is recommending that the proposed Encino/Tarzana Community Plan northern boundary be moved to Victory Blvd to allow Tarzana to be included in only one community plan,

Now therefor, the Tarzana Neighborhood Council supports the L.A. City Redistricting Commission's action that allows the Tarzana Community to be wholly contained within the new Council District 3
