Discussion and motion: The Ad Hoc VNY Committee has requested we consider filing a CIS regarding what is happening at the Van Nuys Airport and that we join SONC in objecting to a proposed lease between the City and Bonseph Helinet. The Executive Committee recommends the following: The TNC Board approve a filing a CIS supporting CF 22-1489 that directs the Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) to report by on the following: List of Projects and Awards; Community Engagement; Compliance with the 2005 VNY Master Plan; Environmental Impacts; and Proposal for Future Community Engagement. And further that all VNY Citizens Advisory Council meetings are recorded and available for the public on LAWA's website within 60 days.
