DRAFT ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION (j) OF SECTION 5.199 OF ARTICLE 3, CHAPTER 12, DIVISION 5 OF THE LOS ANGELES ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO PROHIBIT USE OF THE ANIMAL STERILIZATION FUND FOR STAFF SALARIES AND BENEFITS NOT DIRECTLY RELATED TO STERILIZATION SERVICES OR OTHER DESIGNATED PURPOSED

Honorable Members:

Pursuant to your request, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance amends Subsection (j) of Section 5.199 of Article 3, Chapter 12, Division 5 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) to prohibit the use of the Animal Sterilization Fund (Fund) for staff salaries and benefits not directly related to the delivery or performance of animal sterilization services or other designated purposes.

LAAC Section 5.199 established the Fund to provide animal sterilization services to City residents. In addition, Section 5.199 allows the Fund to be used to establish and finance a public education program to help address the overpopulation of dogs and cats, to establish and finance a follow-up program to ensure that animals sold or given away by the Department of Animal Services (Department) are spayed or neutered, and to pay any additional costs incurred by the City because of the enactment of certain sections of the California Food and Agricultural Code. The draft ordinance would

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amend Section 5.199(j) to specifically prohibit use of the Fund for staff salaries and benefits not directly related to the specified purposes.
