

ORDINANCE NO. _____

An ordinance amending Subsection (j) of Section 5.199 of Article 3, Chapter 12, Division 5 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to prohibit the use of the Animal Sterilization Fund for staff salaries and benefits not directly related to sterilization services or other designated purposes.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Subsection (j) of Section 5.199 of Article 3, Chapter 12, Division 5 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to read as follows:

(j) The Fund shall be administered and expenditures shall be authorized by the General Manager of the Department in accordance with established City practices. Expenditures of funds shall be made for the purpose of providing animal sterilization services and for purposes as stated in Subsection (h) of this section. No expenditures from the Fund shall be used for staff salaries or benefits that are not directly related to the delivery or performance of the sterilization services or other specific purposes designated by Subsections (b) and (h) of this section.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
