Your Community Impact Statement has been successfully submitted by your Community Impact Statement filer to the Board of Animal Services Commissioners.

As a reminder, Pursuant to Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 22.819, a Neighborhood Council may take a formal position on a matter by way of a Community Impact Statement (CIS) or written resolution. If the Neighborhood Council would like to be heard on its CIS or resolution at a Commission meeting, the Neighborhood Council representative must provide the Commission with a copy of the CIS or Resolution sufficiently in advance for review, possible inclusion on the agenda, and posting on the Commission's website.

If the CIS or Resolution pertains to a matter *listed on the Commission's agenda*, during the time the matter is heard, the designated Neighborhood Council representative will have an opportunity to present the Neighborhood Council's formal position. In the Chair's discretion, the Neighborhood Council representative may be asked to have a seat at the table (or equivalent for a virtual meeting) typically reserved for City staff and may provide the Neighborhood Council representative more time than allotted to members of the general public. If the CIS or Resolution pertains to a matter *not listed on the agenda*, the designated Neighborhood Council Representative may speak during General Public Comments.

Summary: Resolved: The Tarzana Neighborhood Council Board approves the recommendation of the Animal Welfare Committee to pass a resolution requesting the Department of Animal Services and General Services Department better coordinate efforts to repair broken kennels and other items at the Animal Shelters. Broken guillotine doors separating portions of the dog kennels, broken locks, and other needed repairs not only make it more difficult to care for and take animals out of the kennels, they also constitute a safety hazard for volunteers and employees. One suggestion is for a list of broken items to be kept in the volunteer office at each shelter, and for a General Services truck to visit each shelter every week for those repairs to be made. The resolution will be sent to the General Managers and/or other employees/managers of the Department of Animal Services and General Services Department, as well as members of the City Council.
