Discussion and possible motion: Resolved that the Tarzana Neighborhood Council Animal Welfare Committee recommends that the Tarzana Neighborhood Council write a letter requesting Councilman Blumenfield and Councilman Koretz to introduce a motion directing the person or persons working on the Trap Neuter Release (TNR) CEQA review to report back to the City Council within 30 days on the status of the injunction against City participation in TNR program.
5. Discuss the spread of panleukopenia (aka panleuk), a deadly cat disease.
6. Discuss other issues regarding the West Valley Animal Shelter.
7. Discuss the possibility of implementing a program for nursing homes in Tarzana, and the Jewish Home in Reseda, to adopt or foster dogs and/or cats.
