Portola Charter Middle School is a Title 1 school home to approximately 1,700 student of which 544 reside in the city of Tarzana. Portola's library is a robust learning environment where students, teachers, and parents engage in:

1. Exploring books (hard copies and online) to read and/or check out
2. Research
3. Teacher librarian led lessons
4. Multi-cultural exhibits
5. School club meetings such as: California Junior Scholarship Federation, Cultural Club, Chess Club, Debate Club, Peer Tutoring Support, Book Clubs
6. Professional development training
7. Parent workshops/lectures

Our library has been neglected for years as our budget has prioritized allocation of funds to class size reduction and instructional material.
